How can it be Week 8 already! We have a busy 4 weeks coming up so please make sure you are keeping up to date with school events on our Facebook page, via our newsletter and from next week – via the newsfeed on the Sentral for Parents App.

Sentral App for Parents – please connect ASAP

We now have the majority of our parents connected to the Sentral app. If you are still to connect, please do so as soon as possible so that you can receive notifications on your phone in regard to student absences, upcoming events, as well as being able to keep in contact with your child's class teacher when required. Please contact the office if you are still having trouble accessing Sentral. The codes were all resent this week to families who are yet to connect.

Teacher Messaging

The SENTRAL Parent Portal allows families to message their child's classroom teacher privately, similar to the Class Dojo App used last year. <u>Please note</u>: all urgent information needs to be phoned through to the school office. Examples include, changes to pick up arrangements, early leavers information, messages/information required for that day. **Teacher correspondence via the Sentral app should always be non-urgent communication**.

Please do not send through messages specific to that school day to the teacher via Sentral, as they may not access the messages during the school day.

<u>Protocol for use of teacher messaging</u>: assume the teacher will not see or respond to messages on the same day. If a response is required by the teacher, they will make every effort to get back to you as quickly as possible. Classroom teachers' main priority is to be present and active in responding to day-to-day teaching and the wellbeing of their students. Responding to these nonurgent requests, will be handled within a reasonable time frame according to the teacher's current workload at that time. Staff have been told not to read and respond to messages between the hours of 5:00pm and 7:00am as their family time is just as valuable as yours.

National Assessment Program - Literacy & Numeracy (NAPLAN)

This week NAPLAN assessments started for our students in Years 3 and 5. We have been very proud of the way all students have approached the assessments with positive attitudes, knowing that they only need to try their best. Information harvested from these assessments are used by the school to drive future directions in teaching. I would like to remind everyone, these are a point in time snapshot of student progress and should not cause any distress to students. Testing is a usual part of our teaching and learning programs.

P&C AGM

A reminder the next P&C meeting is Tuesday 21st March, 2023 at 7:00pm in the Staffroom. This is the Annual General Meeting (AGM) where the P&C will vote for key positions such as President, Treasurer, Secretary etc. The P&C are a valued part of this school and they do a wonderful job managing our Canteen, running the Clothing Pool and raising funds for specific school needs.

MSP Photography will be taking class, individual and sibling photos in Week 10 on **Thursday 30th March, 2023.** Students should wear full school uniform on the day with black shoes. Each student should have received a photo flyer with their name and class on the front. Details regarding options for photo packages, prices and payment are available online by logging onto: <u>www.msp.com.au</u>

Some points to remember when ordering are:

Individual student names and Shoot Key numbers are printed on the flyer that students bring home. The bottom section of the flyer should be retained by you for future reference. It is preferred that all payments are to be made online directly to MSP. **Mastercard or Visa credit/debit cards are accepted.**

Spare envelopes for individual students are available at the front office, if flyers are lost or for those students who are new to the school and may not have received a personalised flyer. These envelopes do not have a Shootkey. **Payment may be made online or in cash on photo da**y.

EACH CHILD WILL NEED TO BRING THEIR FLYER AND/OR SPARE ENVELOPE AND SIBLING ENVELOPES TO SCHOOL <u>ON PHOTO DAY</u>, NOT BEFOREHAND. Each child will take their own envelope to the photographer when it is their turn to be photographed.

Family envelopes for **sibling photos** are available at the front office on request. **These are not automatically sent home.** These envelopes also have a Shootkey, allowing parents to pay online.

** Please ensure your children know that they are having a family photo taken and to provide MSP with their sibling photo envelope on the day, as only those who present their envelopes to MSP will have sibling photos taken. Unfortunately, we will have no other way of knowing which families require sibling photos.

Single Parent Families

Please label your envelope/flyer as 'Mum's Copy' or 'Dad's Copy'. These photos will be kept at the office to be collected by the parent/carer who placed the order.

NEWS FROM THE GARDEN

With the warm weather over the holidays and Mr Curry watering the garden, our vegetables and herbs grew profusely.

The Green Team has been very committed weeding and harvesting the gardens. The gardens are now looking tamed and tidy. Our passionfruit vine has taken off with a magnificent display of flowers that will soon turn into lovely passionfruits.

The students were amazed at the size of some of our cucumbers and were excited collecting approximately 20 and taking them home to add to their sandwiches and salads.

Our silverbeet, basil and tomatoes have been the best performers. The students have been harvesting large amounts of each, taking home large handfuls. Perfect for

lasagne, bolognese or ravioli. To ensure your cut basil stays fresh, pop the stems in a jar of water just as you would do with a bunch of cut flowers. If you keep the stems in water, your basil should last just over a week and you can pick at the leaves when required to add flavour to your cooking.

We are starting to get the garden beds ready for planting our new vegetables and herbs, including capsicum, corn and beetroot.
