#### Term 4 Staff Development Days

The Department of Education has two scheduled Staff Development Days at the end of Term 4 – 18th and 19th December, 2023.

This year, our staff are going to be undertaking two twilight professional learning sessions throughout Term 4 in lieu of the Staff Development Day on the 19th December, 2023. Staff will be attending an On Country professional learning with Stu McMinn from Gawura Cultural Immersions to continue to deepen the staff knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal history and culture. The second twilight session will see staff trained in CPR and Anaphylaxis as part of our annual compliance training. These arrangements will mean the school will be non-operational on Tuesday 19th December, 2023 however this will not affect families as the students last day of the year is Friday 15th December, 2023.

#### Sental for Parents - our main source of communication moving forward

We still have a number of families who are not yet connected to the Sentral for Parents portal. This is an important communication tool that teachers use to communicate with parents. If you are not signed up you may be missing important messages from your child's teacher that are specific to their class.

From Term 3, we will no longer be sending out SMS messages for absences, messages will be sent via the Sentral app. Later this year, the Sentral app will also be used for notes and payments of excursions and from next year, it will be used to distribute student academic reports digitally.

#### Early/Late Arrivals

If you are dropping off your child/ren later than 8:55am or picking them up earlier than 2:55pm, please make sure you come into our office and speak to our office staff to sign in/sign out.

Students who are late to school MUST be accompanied by an adult to the office or the late arrival will be deemed unjustified.

#### Notifying of absences

If your child is going to be away, you are welcome to call our office to let us know, you can complete the absence in the Sentral for Parents App or alternatively a text message is sent out at 10:00am each day that you can reply to.

#### **Covid Update**

We have confirmed cases of Covid in all grades across the school. If your child has symptoms, please test them for Covid before sending them to school. Students who have tested positive for Covid, <u>need to remain at home until symptom free</u>. Any child who is unwell, whether testing positive or not, should remain at home until they feel well enough to attend school.

All students will be coming home with a new box of 5 RATs this week. If you still have old stock at home, please check the use by dates as some of our original tests have expired.

### School student travel information for parents and students

### **School Travel Passes**

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass but have not yet applied need to <u>apply</u> or <u>update</u> their details as soon as possible.

In the Opal network, students should travel with a Child/Youth Opal card until they receive their valid School Opal card. If outside Greater Sydney, parents should contact their <u>local bus operator</u> to discuss their travel needs.

New Student Opal cards (including new Term Bus Passes) will be sent to the student's nominated postal address within two weeks of their application being approved.

Students living in rural and regional areas will receive their travel pass from their nominated transport operator. It may be issued via their school or be sent directly to them at home. **Note**: some rural and regional operators do not issue travel passes. Students/parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

#### **Terms of Use**

Students using Opal cards must tap on and tap off in line with the Opal terms of use.

All students are required to comply with the <u>Student code of conduct</u>. The code of conduct aims to ensure the safety and well-being of school children and other passengers. It is important that parents ensure their child is aware of this, as failure to comply with the code of conduct can result in a suspension from travel.
