BYOD REQUIREMENTS 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware, students in Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6) have the option to participate in our Bring Your Own Device (**BYOD**) program. As your child will be in Stage 3 next year, we have provided this information so that you may plan for 2025.

What is BYOD?

Students can bring personal devices to school to be used in the classroom, under the direction of the class teacher, for activities linked to class learning programs. The hardware and software requirements of devices supported by our policy are listed in the table below.

Please note, <u>it is not essential</u> that your child brings a personal device to school, they will still be able to access the school shared devices if you choose not to take up this policy. Also, the preferred device is a Windows laptop or MacBook, due to accessibility and reliability.

Please note that students have free access to Office 365 through the Department of Education. This can be installed via the online software from the Student Portal.

Please also note that Android devices are not listed as they have been found to be unreliable when using the Department of Education Wi-Fi network.
